NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- All racing will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia Inc will apply

2 ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

3* ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

All boats registered with Abbotsford Flying Squadron are registered for all events as part of that registration.

Registration is open to the following classes of boat

Flying 11

Laser

420

Cherub

12 Foot Skiff

Open class

Conduct of individual class club championships and point scores is subject to the registration of sufficient boats.

Visitors may enter on the day by invitation, but are not eligible for points or trophies. Such invitations may be withdrawn after 3 races in a season.

4 FEES

Only financial members of Abbotsford 12 foot Flying Squadron are eligible to register boats and apply for storage in the Club. Current fees are available from the Secretary.

5 SCHEDULE

Registration at the clubhouse on the afternoon of the first Saturday in September or as notified on the Club website.

First race as per sailing instructions

6 MEASUREMENT

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate on request. Any boat unable to present a valid certificate shall be allocated to the open class unless the boat is accepted by the sailing committee as eligible to compete in a particular class.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on registration day

8 THE COURSES

Courses are sailed on Parramatta River between Gladesville Bridge and Putney Point. Class Course sheets are available at the Clubhouse on registration day.

9 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats will be on the water for the duration of racing. Competitors may provide additional support boats with the understanding that they may be called upon to assist when required.

10 BOAT STORAGE

Boat storage areas in the Clubhouse may be made available by the committee for the storage of registered boats owned by Club members subject to the payment of an annual fee and acceptance of current conditions. Allocation of a storage area will be at the discretion of the Club Captain.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12 INSURANCE

Each participating boat should be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000
