Cadet Race Series commences MIDDAY to 1.00pm, informal racing, without instructors on board

Club Racing Series Commences (2.00pm to 5.00pm) Formal racing competition for Spring, Summer & Autumn seasons with point scores and Seasonal Trophies and club Championships.
